been nominated for three Emmy Awards and won four Writers Guild of America Awards plus a special WGA Award. Her work has been nominated and won Golden Globes, Emmys, DGA, SAG, Humanitas, and Pen Awards. A member of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences and The Academy of Televisions Arts and Sciences, Nagle is also former Governor of the Writers Branch. Nagle is currently developing projects with Paramount Plus, Blumhouse, Maven, CBS Studios and WB. She recently produced and wrote With/In an anthology of 13 short films in 2021 with Julianne Moore, Don Cheadle and Rebecca Hall. She was nominated for a Humanitas Prize for her work.

Nagle wrote the script for "The Good Lie," produced by Ron Howard starring Reese Witherspoon. Released in 2015 by Warner Brothers and received an A+ CinemaScore.

Wrote and exec produced the pilot for American TV series of "The Red Band Society" for Fox with Steven Spielberg.

Nagle was a Supervising Producer and writer on the HBO award winning TV series "Boardwalk Empire" seasons 1 and 2. Martin Scorcese and Mark Wahlberg Executive produced.

Her first script, HBO's "Warm Springs" received a record-breaking 16 Emmy nominations and won five Emmys including the Award for Best Television Movie. It also won the Writers Guild of America Award for Long Form Original Screenplay.
