Terri Minsky is an American television writer and producer, who created *Lizzie McGuire*, *Andi Mack*, *Less Than Perfect*, and *The Geena Davis Show*. Minsky also wrote several episodes of *Sex and the City*. Minsky was the executive producer of *Sherri*, a Lifetime series that ran for one season in 2009. In 2014, Minsky co-wrote the pilot for MTV's *Finding Carter*, which debuted on July 8, 2014, and was the show's executive producer for its first season.

Her first writing credit was for the series *Doctor Doctor* in 1989, and she also worked on *Flying Blind* in 1992. She grew up in Mt. Lebanon, Pennsylvania.^[1]

A mother of two, Minsky published a reflection, "The Mother Load", on balancing time between her work and family in *Literary Mama*.

Prior to working in television, Minsky was a writer for the *Wall Street Journal*, the *Boston Globe*, the *New York Daily News*, *Premiere*, *New York*, and *Esquire*.^[2]

She was set to write a revival series of *Lizzie McGuire* for Disney+. However, Minsky had exited Disney+ due to creative differences since the first two episodes were filmed and the revival has been officially cancelled.
