(FROM MY APRIL 2015 LETTER TO THE GETTY RESEARCH INSTITUTE) (they ultimately took a donation of 7 boxes of files in 2019)

"I am a location manager who works in television commercials primarily now but have been in television and some feature films since I entered the business in 1980.

My generation of location mgr used physical photography on film and pasted up panoramas of overlapping pictures onto manila folders as our primary method of presentation before the digital age.

Many of us kept files of these folders for years and now this generation is disgorging and throwing away these research materials as there is aging in the population and downsizing happening even as we speak.

I have taken it upon myself to acquire two large collections from two prominent location mgrs with voluminous files to prevent their destruction, but I know of several others that are on the verge of having to make decisions about the fate of their files.

In a very real sense, these files in aggregate act as sort of a voluminous time capsule Of visual information about Los Angeles' exterior and interior spaces of all sorts of places.

Would the Getty be interested in taking as many files as can be donated in one fell swoop?

I could get the location mgr Guild of America, a professional association we formed to advance our interests in the business, to put the word out to everyone that the Getty is interested. I would be happy to donate these two collections and mine, but I mean if you are, you would be the perfect candidate to take this giant aggregation of manila folders with photographs taped to them in one place, even if all you did was store it for a generation and deal with evaluating its cultural and historical significance later. Because I/ we can't afford to rent a storage space and I think that this opportunity will probably pass as I can't take on any more myself and other collections will probably go into the landfill.

Please let me know if you have any interest in seeing what some of this stuff looks like and what it might represent.

But just for example, we do randomly thorough panoramic coverage in photography of streets, parking lots, landscapes, rooftops, houses, mansions, ordinary houses, schools, universities,

basements, prisons, hospitals, hotels, bridges, alleys, rooftops, natural settings, roads, AND MORE etc all over Los Angeles that capture particular places and times in unusually thorough fashion for the purposes of location consideration.

I suspect that the "Then and now" opportunities alone, in the future, will be missed if this pile of photographs ends up in the landfill, but more than that I think that there is genuine cultural value in all of his photography.

To start off, I have been scouting for approximately the past 24 years. I started off in the non union days of car commercials and print ads.

I transitioned to features in 1995. My first job was "Starship Troppers", and have done many projects since then (but not as many as the esteemed Scott Logan).

The bulk of the location folders were generated on "School for Scoundrels looking for East Coast Architecture", "Bioshock / looking for Mid Century homes", "Superman / DC Architecture and Farm Land", "S.W.A.T / LA City Architecture", "Rush Hour 2 and 3 / LA + Hong Kong + Parisian Architecture", amongst many other Commercials. I have quite a few locations as well that are not in Los Angeles PROPER, and located in various other California Locations. I have about 10-14 remaining banker boxes of white file folders. They have been stored in my garage in Venice in various 2 and 4 drawer file cabinets.

Other recent correspondence text:

I am a location manager and amateur archivist who has volunteered to aggregate all of the surviving Manila folders of location scouting photography that predate digital photography in the location scouting field.

This is a vast array of all types of locations (<u>http://film.ca.gov/wp-content/uploads/2017/03/</u> <u>CinemaScout-Categories-2016.pdf</u>) thoroughly covered for Directors and Production Designers to consider from various angles.

Typically, location managers shot panoramas by overlapping individual images and then taped those pictures together into finished panoramas and mounted them on legal sized manilla folders, which were "nested" / taped together into the finished presentation folder.

Since locations changed and disappeared over time, location managers historically saved their folders for research and posterity.

Eventually, everybody wearied of holding their folders so they either pitched them or donated them to the California film commission, which maintained a library.

Two years ago, the commission had to get rid of their library in the interest of space, and I volunteered to rescue it and store if for the time being.

I have approximately 600 linear feet of Manila folders with taped and/or glued color photographs processed at 1 hour photo labs between approximately 1982 and 2003.

I am looking for a home for this archive. Please let me know if we could discuss possibilities. I am storing this archive on my property in Highland Park.

I am preparing to go through the archive and start pitching things I think aren't worth preserving for historical / architectural reasons, but will keep "lost locations", streetscapes, etc. - things I think might be worth preserving for future generations of historians to look at.

A permanent home for the archive, once edited, is being sought. Please let me know if you are interested in helping me find such a home.

2016 letter to LA Times pitching a story to promote this archive's value:

Hi Richard. I have a story idea for you. My name is Robert Mendel and I'm a location manager and an assistant director now retired from television but still working as a location scout and manager in commercials.

Recently the California Film Commission had to let go of their location scouting photography Library to make room for office cubicles for the additional staff required to help administer the incentive program, and because I have aggregated a lot of location managers old photography archives, I stepped up and took the California Film commission archive and joined it with the one I had been accumulating over the years. As a result I now have probably the last remaining Archive of old location scouting photography in the county that spans the years 1982 to roughly 2004 when digital photography took over.

I've approached the Getty Research Institute to donate this gigantic collection and they are very seriously considering it. The curators for architecture photography are coming to my house the week of July 25th to look at this massive archive as they have yet to render a decision on whether to take it or not.

But they're taking it very seriously. I would love to invite you to come over and witness them going through everything if you would like. To give you an idea of the scope of this collection it runs about 800 plus linear feet of manila folders with one hour photo lab photos and panoramic taped together overlapping pictures. It's crazy huge.

An artist in Las Vegas has birriwed some pictures that were scouted for the movie Casino and were donated by the location scout who took them to a university there, and has turned some of them into art pieces with an accompanying article where she quite lucidly comments about the inadvertently historical nature of old location scouting photography.

I hope this might be of interest to your readers as the history of moviemaking in Los Angeles County is intrinsically involved with this collection. I don't want it all to end up in the landfill when i die, and I have to get some kind of commitment from some institution willing to take something so huge. I hope it is the Getty since they would actually curate it, but Hollywood Heritage has volunteered to Warehouse it, at the very least, if I can't find anybody more Well Suited.

The LA Public Library has basically said they would be interested but it's size is prohibitively large.
